

CUESD School Emergency Guide For Parents

Communication



- Official CUESD communication will be via ParentSquare, District and/or school site websites.
- Do not call your child on a cell phone.
- Please wait for instructions from the school/district on how you can be reunited with your student.
- Please do not call the school during an emergency. You may not be able to speak with anyone, and you may tie up telephone lines necessary for communicating with emergency personnel.

At School



- Schools are the safest places to be in an emergency.
- Each school has a disaster preparedness plan, with teachers, administrators, and other personnel trained to supervise, counsel, and care for students.
- As public employees, all District employees are disaster service workers and are prepared to protect all of our students during an emergency (California GC Section 3100-3109).
- · CUESD schools have water, food and other emergency supplies.

Reunification



- Prepare to arrive calm, patient, and ready to follow district/emergency staff instructions; encourage others to do the same.
- Parents/emergency contact designees will be expected to wait outside the school or at reunification areas until all students are accounted for, and authorized personnel begin the Student Release Process.
- Parent/emergency contact designees must have a Driver's License or other photo identification.
- District and/or school employees will match the names of parents/emergency contact designees with students. Only the individuals listed will be allowed to pick up students.
- Parents/emergency contact designees will sign the student out at the Student Release Area.
- Students will be released in an orderly manner to ensure safety and properly account for all students.
